Dear Student

You are approaching a crucial period in your lives, with GCSE exams looming and the need to choose the educational pathway which will best suit your future plans and career options.

The Sixth Form at Ysgol Bro Hyddgen can offer a wide range of academic and vocational courses through the medium of Welsh or English, details of which can be found in this prospectus.

Like most sixth formers in Wales, as well as studying 3 or 4 Advanced Subsidiary (AS) or vocational courses (BTEC or OCR) or a combination of these courses, you will also be studying for the Welsh Baccalaureate qualification. This is a recognised graded: A* - E qualification.

Although the Sixth Form at Ysgol Bro Hyddgen is expanding, it is still small enough for us to be able to respond to the needs of the individual. In most cases, subjects aren't tied to option columns. This allows students to make an open choice. We ask you to let us know your requirements as soon as possible and to confirm these after the GCSE results so that we can adjust the timetable to your needs.

During your time in the Sixth Form there will be opportunities for personal development by means of the school's pastoral care programme. You will also be given the chance to develop your leadership skills through organising activities such as the school eisteddfod, raising money for charity, shows or school concerts.

Sixth form students are now accommodated in the Hyddgen Learning Centre where they have priority access to the excellent resources. The school library is also available for private study. Our students are very happy here, and those who have joined us from other schools say that it is very easy to settle in and make new friends.

Applications are welcomed from students of all abilities, interests & background providing we offer a suitable course for you; you have suitable qualifications (see below); you dedicate yourself to the work and you take responsibility for managing your time wisely.

All the best in your GCSE exams and I look forward to welcoming you to the Sixth Form at Ysgol Bro Hyddgen.

Mae Ysgol Bro Hyddgen yn ysgol 4 – 18 oed gyda rhyw 550 o ddisgyblion wedi ei lleoli ar ddau safle ar gyrrion tref Machynlleth. Mae canran uchel o'r disgyblion yn byw yn y dref ac y mae'r lleill yn dod o gefndir gwledig. Rydym yn derbyn disgyblion o dair sir: Powys, Gwynedd a Cheredigion. Mae'r dalgylch ym Mhowys yn ymestyn mor bell â Charno yn y dwyrain ac Aberangell yn y gogledd-ddwyrain. Awdurdod Addysg Powys sy'n gyfrifol am yr ysgol ond y mae trefniadau hefyd i dderbyn disgyblion o Wynedd a Cheredigion.

Welcome

Ysgol Bro Hyddgen is a newly established 4 – 18 school of around 550 pupils, situated on two sites at the edges of the town. Although a large percentage of the pupils live in town, a significant number come from a more rural background. We receive pupils from three counties: Powys, Gwynedd and Ceredigion. The Powys section of the catchment area extends as far east as Carno and to Aberangell in the north-east. The school is run by Powys Education Authority but arrangements are made for extra-district pupils from Gwynedd and Ceredigion.

We pride ourselves in being a homely, welcoming school trying our utmost to provide the best possible education for our pupils.

The School Site

The school grounds are attractive and the secondary school's playing fields are adjacent to the school and in excellent condition. Although we have a recently refurbished gymnasium, the school also makes use of the facilities available in the nearby Leisure Centre. There is a cycle shelter for pupils who cycle to school. The Hyddgen Centre opened in January 2009 and is a wonderful building which provides pupils with a state of the art learning environment.

Cyrsiau Uwch Gyfrannol ac Uwch

Ym Mlwyddyn 12 gallwch ddewis pynciau **Uwch Gyfrannol (UG)** yn unig neu gyfuno pynciau **Uwch Gyfrannol** gyda phynciau **Galwedigaethol**, (gweler isod). Y Pynciau UG yw'r 40% cyntaf i'r cymhwyster **Safon Uwch (A2)** llawn. Bydd y mwyaf o'r myfyrwyr yn astudio tri phwnc ym Mlwyddyn 12 yn ogystal â'r Fagloriaeth.

Cyrsiau Galwedigaethol (BTEC & OCR)

Cymhwyster yw hwn sy'n sefyll ochr yn ochr â Safon Uwch ond sydd yn perthyn yn agosach i fyd gwaith. Fel arfer bydd angen astudio'r pwnc am ddwy flynedd er mwyn sicrhau cymhwyster.

Modylau

Caiff y cyrsiau UG a Safon Uwch Galwedigaethol eu dysgu'n fodylol gyda dau gyfle asesiad ar gyfer y modylau UG ac un ar gyfer y modylau A2. Gallwch ailsefyll y modylau UG ar ddiwedd Blwyddyn 13. Y marc uchaf sydd bob amser yn cyfrif.

Sut i ddewis eich pynciau

Bydd yr ysgol yn gwneud ei gorau i gynnig amrediad llawn o gyrsiau UG a Safon Uwch Galwedigaethol fydd yn ateb eich anghenion chi fel myfyrwyr. Wrth ddewis, dylech ystyried y canlynol:

- Beth yw eich lefel gallu yn y pwnc?
 - Yn y mwyaf o'r pynciau, disgwylir i chi fod wedi ennill o leiaf gradd B mewn TGAU yn y pwnc
 - Mewn pynciau eraill nid oes rheidrwydd i chi fod wedi eu hastudio i TGAU
- Eich dyheadau i'r dyfodol



Courses

AS and A Level Courses

In Year 12 you will choose Advanced Subsidiary (AS) subjects or combine Advanced Subsidiary subjects with Vocational subjects (see below). AS subjects are the first half of the full A Level (A2) qualification. Most students will choose 3 AS subjects and the Welsh Baccalaureate.

Vocational Qualifications (BTEC & OCR)

This qualification is designed to stand alongside A levels, but is more directly related to the world of work. Usually the course needs to be studied for 2 years in order to achieve the qualification.

Modules

Both the A Level and Vocational courses are modular with two assessment opportunities for the AS modules and one for the A2 modules. AS assessments can be re-taken at the end of Year 13. The higher mark will always be the one taken into account.

How to choose your subjects

The school will do its best to offer a full range of AS/A2 & Vocational courses. When making your choices you should consider the following:

- Your level of interest in the subject
- Your level of ability in the subject
 - Some subjects expect you to have gained at least a B grade in GCSE
 - Some subjects can be taken at A level without having previously been studied at GCSE
- Your future aspirations

What are your future plans?

It's important you discuss your plans with your Careers Officer, Head of Sixth Form and subject teachers.

During your **Independent Study Lessons** you can use the school library or **Hyddgen**.

No more than one lesson a day should be seen as a 'free' lesson. The rest of your time will be filled with Welsh Baccalaureate lessons:

- Enterprise & Employability Challenge
- Global Citizenship Challenge
- Community Challenge
- Individual Project

Time will also be allocated for general Physical education activities. Sixth Formers at Ysgol Bro Hyddgen can use the sporting facilities at the Leisure Centre during school hours and are encouraged to make the most of the provision.

Mentoring

In order to ensure progression and success individual interviews are arranged every half term with your personal **mentor**.

Personal Development and the Welsh Baccalaureate

There's more to life in the Sixth Form than conventional lessons:

Students are encouraged to undertake **voluntary community work** and to offer support and guidance to younger children by means of the following:

- APAUSE (peer delivery of sex education)
- School Spelling & Reading support programmes
- Maths Rescue
- 5X60 Activities
- The School Council
- Fund raising
- Students will also be given the opportunity to develop their **Entrepreneurial & Working with Others Skills** along with volunteering in the local community
- Students will also be encouraged to arrange relevant **Work Experience**
- Students' general knowledge will be enhanced in the **Welsh Baccalaureate** lessons.
- Throughout their time in the Sixth Form, students' **Numeracy, Communication & ICT** skills will be addressed

All the above elements are assessed and recognised by the Welsh Baccalaureate qualification. These are the skills universities and employers are looking for in prospective students and employees.

Disgyblaeth Bositif

Er mwyn meithrin a chynnal ymddygiad da, mae'r ysgol wedi buddsoddi mewn system gyfrifiadurol soffistigedig ar gyfer cofnodi ymddygiad da a drwg. Os bydd y disgylbion yn ymddwyn yn dda, bydd rhieni yn derbyn negeseuon testun a'ch plant yn derbyn tystysgrifau a gwobrau eraill.

Os bydd disgylb yn camymddwyn, bydd hynny yn cael ei

gofnodi'n electroneg a chaiff neges destun ei hanfon adref, ac efallai bydd angen trefnu cyfweliad i drafod yr ymddygiad a sut y gallwn helpu'r disgylb wella. Gall cosb gynnwys aros i mewn yn ystod amser egwyl neu amser cinio, neu ar ôl ysgol (rhoddir o leiaf 24 awr o rybudd os digwydd hyn). Mae'n bosib y caiff y plentyn ei roi ar adroddiad.

Pe digwydd i ddisgylb barhau i ymddwyn yn wael neu i wneud rhywbeth difrifol, gallai gael ei atal o wersi neu o'r ysgol am gyfnod o amser. Os bydd y disgylb yn cael ei wahardd yn barhaol, yna mae'n rhaid i'r penderfyniad gael ei gadarnhau gan banel y Corff Llywodraethol, a'i dderbyn neu ei newid. Os yw rhiant / ofalwr yn dymuno apelio yn erbyn unrhyw benderfyniad ynglŷn â gwaharddiad a wnaed gan yr ysgol, yna dylid gwneud hyn yn ysgrifenedig i Gadeirydd y Corff Llywodraethwyr a'r Cyfarwyddwr Addysg.

Mae'r ysgol yn sefyll yn gryf yn erbyn bwlio. Anogir pob disgylb i ddweud wrth ei Diwtor Dosbarth (neu unrhyw aelod o'r staff) am unrhyw ddigwyddiad ac mae 2 focs postio ar gael i alluogi'r disgylb roi neges gyfrinachol (wedi ei arwyddo) ynglŷn ag unrhyw beth sy'n ei boeni. Gellir hefyd danfon e-bost at bwlio@brohyddgen.powys.sch.uk

Ni chaniateir i ddisgylbion Blynnyddoedd 7 - 11adael tir yr ysgol ar unrhyw adeg. Caniateir i fyfyrwyr Blynnyddoedd 12 & 13adael tir yr ysgol amser cinio. Dylai ffonau symudol gael eu cadw ar *silent* yn ystod gwersi. Dylai eitemau gwerthfawr gael eu cadw'n ddiogel yn y Swyddfa.



Behaviour

13

Ysgol Bro Hyddgen has high expectations of good behaviour. All pupils are expected to work hard and to behave well. Staff treat pupils with courtesy and expect courtesy in return. Pupils are expected to treat each other with respect. Those who behave particularly well are rewarded.

Code of behaviour at Ysgol Bro Hyddgen

- Treat others as you would like to be treated yourself
- Use appropriate language
- Show respect for other people, for your school work, for your property and the property of others
- Listen to teachers and to each other
- Co-operate with your teachers
- Learn to work together
- Move about the school in an orderly way
- Arrive promptly and be ready for lessons with books and equipment
- Take pride in the appearance of the school
- Work hard at all times

Positive Discipline

In order to encourage and sustain good behaviour, the school has invested in a highly sophisticated computer system for recording and collating good and bad behaviour. In the case of good behaviour, this will lead to parents receiving letters of commendation, and pupils will be given certificates and other rewards.

In the case of bad behaviour, the system triggers a

sequence of events beginning with a letter and continuing with an invitation to attend a meeting to discuss the problem and how best to help the pupil mend his/her ways. Sanctions include break or lunch-time detention, being placed 'on report' or after school detention (parents will be given 24 hours' notice of this)

If a pupil persistently misbehaves or his/her behaviour is particularly unacceptable, he/she will be suspended from lessons or from school for a period of time. The school has the right to suspend pupils for 45 school days a year. If a pupil is suspended for more than 5 days, a Governing Body panel meets to consider the suspension. If a pupil is to be expelled permanently, then this decision is discussed by a Governors' Panel and will be either confirmed or changed. There is a right of appeal which should be made in writing to the Chairperson of the Governing Body and the Director of Education.

The school makes a strong stand against bullying. All pupils are encouraged to tell tutors (or any member of staff) about any incident. Two post boxes are placed in the school for any child to write a (signed) note in confidence to the Headteacher about anything which is upsetting them. It is also possible to send an e-mail to bullying@brohyddgen.powys.sch.uk which is opened by the heads of year.

Year 7- 11 pupils are not allowed to leave the school grounds at any time. Years 12 & 13 are allowed to leave the school at lunch time. Mobile phones should be set at 'silent' during lessons. Items of value should be given in at the Office where they will be stored in a safe.

Mae aelodau o'r staff yn canfod yr Anghenion Arbennig ar gyfer y disgybl. Mae Cynllun Addysg Unigol yn cael ei baratoi ar gyfer y disgybl gan y Cyd-gysylltydd Anghenion Arbennig, **Mr Iwan Biffin**. Gall hyn olygu fod y disgybl yn derbyn sylw o fewn grŵp bychan ac yn ystod cyfnod di-wers.

Gweithredu gan yr ysgol + mwy

Yn y Cynllun Hygyrchedd, bwriad y Corff Llywodraethol yw hwyluso mynediad hawdd i'r ysgol pan fo angen i ddisgyblion ac ymwelwyr gydag anhawsterau clywed neu weld, trwy ddarparu offer pwrrpasol.

Darpariaeth ar gyfer disgyblion Mwy Abl a Thalentog (MGaTh)

Anelwn fel ysgol i sicrhau bod pob disgybl yn cyrraedd ei lawn botensial o ran gallu a thalent. Mae'r term 'mwy galluog' yn cwmpasu disgyblion sy'n fwy galluog yn academaidd ar draws y cwricwlwm; yn gyffredinol yng Nghymru, gall tua 20% o boblogaeth yr ysgol fod yn fwy galluog. Mae'r term 'talentog' yn cwmpasu'r rhai sy'n dangos talent arbennig mewn un maes neu feysydd mwy penodol fel sgiliau chwaraeon, cerddorol yn ogystal â sgiliau arwain a rhyngbersonol. Ar gyfer disgyblion mwy abl a thalentog, anelwn o fewn cymuned yr ysgol yn gwricwlaidd a thu hwnt i gynnig cyfleoedd, cefnogaeth ac arweiniad. Pastoral Care

The following members of staff implement and manage pastoral care:

- Mr Tegid Owen: Years 7, 8 & 9
- Miss Dela Wyn Jones: Years 10 & 11
- Mr Llifon J. Ellis Blwyddyn 12 & 13

This overview brings together all aspects of your child's development and is part of our caring atmosphere.

A brief daily period is held when the pupil's Form Tutor is able to monitor progress and get to know the individual members of the Form. If a problem occurs in the pupil's school life, this is a good opportunity to discuss the matter and receive advice. During the school year the Registration Tutor will also interview each pupil individually.

Special Educational Needs

The school's Special needs Policy is based on the LEA Policy and the school's interpretation of the Special Educational Needs Code of Practice, 2002.

The 3 statutory classifications of SEN are interpreted as follows:

School Action

Teachers identify needs. Individual Educational Plans (IEPs) are prepared by the SEN Co-ordinator (SENCO: **Mr Iwan Biffin**) This may mean that the pupil will be given special attention within a small group during non-teaching periods.

School Action +

The Pupil continues to experience problems. The IEP is reviewed by the SENCO. Further advice may be required e.g. speech therapist. The Local Authority may provide for additional support within the classroom or for 1 or 2

hours' individual attention every week according to the need.

Statement

A formal statement listing needs and provision is prepared by the Educational Psychologist for pupils with more complex problems who may need the support of a Learning Support Assistant for longer periods of the school day.

Pupils' special needs are usually identified in the primary schools but they may be recognised later as physical, behavioural or social conditions become more apparent.

The ground floor is accessible to pupils with physical disabilities. All except three classrooms are on the ground floor and adjustments can be made to allocation of rooms if necessary so that the full curriculum can be taught to all pupils.

In its Accessibility Plan, The Governing Body intends to provide specialist aids when required for visual or hearing impaired pupils and visitors to the school.

Provision for More Able and Talented students (MAT)

As a school, we aim to ensure that each pupil fulfils his/her potential with regards to ability and talent. The term 'more able' refers to pupils who are academically more able across the curriculum; in Wales, approximately 20% of the school population can be more able. The 'talented' refers to those pupils who show a special talent in one field or in more specific fields such as sports skills, musical ability as well as leadership and interpersonal skills. For the more able and talented within the school community, we offer through the curriculum and beyond, opportunities, support and guidance. We aim to recognise more able and talented pupils using several methods including external examination and assessment results, internal examination and assessment results, the professional opinions of teachers, communication with external bodies, and also through discussion with parents.

Y Cyngor Ysgol

Mae Cyngor yr ysgol wedi hen sefydlu, ac mae cynrychiolydd o bob dosbarth yn cael ei ethol yn flynyddol. Mae'r Tim Rheoli a'r Bwrdd Llywodraethol yn gwrando'n astud ar farn y Cyngor Ysgol. Rydym yn falch o weld y disgylion yn gwneud cyfraniad cadarnhaol tuag at fywyd eu hysgol.

Gwersi Offerynnol a Llais

Mae'r ysgol yn trefnu athrawon cerdd teithiol sydd yn cefnogi gwaith yr Adran gerdd. Cynigir gwersi telyn, gitâr, chwythbrennau, drymiau, pres a llais. Mae rhieni'n gwneud cyfraniad ariannol tuag at y gwersi hyn sy'n digwydd yn ystod y diwrnod ysgol.

Lluniaeth

Darperir lluniaeth ysgafn amser egwyl a phrydau bwyd amser cinio yn y ffreutur ble caiff y disgylion wneud eu dewis eu hunain a thalu wrth y ddesg. Mae rhai disgylion yn gallu cael bwyd am ddim a dylid gwneud cais yn fuan yng ngwyliau'r Haf, neu pan fo amgylchiadau teuluol yn newid i'r Swyddfa Addysg Fro, Yr Hen Goleg, Y Drenowydd.

Rydym yn annog disgylion i ddod â photeli dŵr i'r ysgol ac i yfed digon ar hyd y dydd, gan gynnwys yfed dŵr mewn gwersi. Mae ffynhonnau dŵr ar gael yn yr ysgol.

Presenoldeb

Mae presenoldeb yn flaenoriaeth genedlaethol a lleol yng Nghymru. Mae'r chwe Chyfarwyddwr o fewn consortiwm ERW, sy'n cynnwys Powys eisoes wedi gwneud y penderfyniad y dylai pob absenoldeb sy'n deillio o gymryd gwyliau yn ystod y tymor gael ei ystyried fel absenoldeb anawdurdodedig.

Mae'r cysylltiad rhwng presenoldeb da a safonau uchel yn un cryf iawn ac fel y cyfryw, mae'r Cyfarwyddwyr yn awyddus i annog cyfraddau presenoldeb uchel ac i annog rhieni i beidio â chymryd gwyliau yn ystod y tymor. Felly er mis Medi 2013 ni fydd unrhyw bennaeth o fewn y chwe Awdurdod Lleol yn y consortiwm awdurdodi absenoldebau oherwydd gwyliau.

Mae cymryd gwyliau yn ystod y tymor yn golygu bod plant yn colli amser pwysig yn yr ysgol, yn addysgol ac o ran gweithgareddau ysgol eraill. Mae'n anodd iawn i ddisgyblion ddal i fyny ar y gwaith y maent wedi'i goll. Mewn diwrnod ysgol prysur, mae'n anodd i ysgolion ddod o hyd i'r amser

ychwanegol i helpu plentyn i ddal i fyny. Gall absenoldebau cyson effeithio'n andwyol ar gynnydd academiaidd; gall hefyd effeithio ar les cymdeithasol ac emosiynol plentyn. Ceir digon o ymchwil addysgol sy'n cysylltu cyrhaeddad disgylion â phresenoldeb. Mae cyfradd presenoldeb o 90% yn yr ysgol yn cyfateb i golli ½ diwrnod yr wythnos. Byddai hyn yn golygu colli 4 wythnos gyfan yn ystod y flwyddyn ysgol!

Os ydy plentyn yn absennol, gofynnwn yn garedig i rieni ffonio'r ysgol i roi gwylod i ni rhwng 8.00 â 9.00 y bore. Mae'n bwysig eich bod yn gwneud hyn gan y bu achosion trasig mewn rhai ardaloedd o'r wlad oherwydd diffyg cyfathrebu rhwng yr ysgol â'r rhieni. Gwelwch felly ei bod yn bwysig bod gennym ffordd i gysylltu â chi bob amser a diolchwn i chi am ein hysbysu o rifau ffôn perthnasol. Rydym yn gwneud ein gorau i gysylltu â chi os nad oes eglurhad wedi cyrraedd am absenoldeb ac rydym yn cofrestru'r disgylion ym mhob gwers. Ond mae'n rhaid i ni bwystleisio mai cyfrifoldeb y rhiant yw sicrhau bod y plentyn yn yr ysgol. Os yw plentyn yn absennol yn fwy aml na phlant eraill bydd y Swyddog Lles Addysg, sydd yn galw yn yr ysgol yn wythnosol, yn gwneud ymholaiedau a gall alw yn y cartref. O fis Tachwedd 2014 ymlaen gall Awdurdod Addysg Powys weinyddu dirwy ar rieni os yw presenoldeb eu plentyn yn syrthio o dan 90% neu os yw plentyn yn absennol heb ganiatâd am 5 diwrnod mewn cyfnod o 12 wythnos.

Plentyn yn absennol oherwydd salwch (neu unrhyw reswm digonal arall), nodwch y rheswm mewn llythyr os gwelwch yn dda ar ddiwrnod cyntaf y plentyn nôl yn yr ysgol; mae'n ofynnol i ni gadw'r eglurhad ysgrifenedig yn ffeil y disgyl.

Diolch i bob rhiant sydd yn rhoi gwylod i ni am absenoldeb ac yn anfon llythyr o eglurhad am absenoldeb dilys.



Information

School Council

The school has a well-established School Council, with an elected representative from each Tutor group. The opinions expressed in the School Council are always listened to by senior members of staff and sometimes passed on to the Governing Body. We are pleased that pupils make a positive contribution to the running of what is fundamentally their school.

Instrumental and Voice tuition

The school organizes peripatetic music teachers who offer a support service to the Music department. Harp, guitar, woodwind, brass, drums and voice tuition is offered. Parents make financial contributions towards these lessons which are held during the school day.

Refreshments

School dinner and break time snacks are provided in the canteen. Free meals are available in special cases and applications should be made early in the summer holidays or whenever family circumstances change, to the Area Education Office, Old College, Newtown. Pupils should bring drinking water to school in plastic bottles. They are encouraged to drink water throughout the day, including in lessons. Water fountains are placed in the school.

Attendance

Attendance is a national and local priority in Wales. The six directors within the South West and Mid Wales Education Consortium, which includes Powys have already taken the decision that all absences due to pupils going on holiday during term time should be deemed to be unauthorised.

The link between good attendance and high standards is a very strong one and as such, the Directors are eager to encourage high attendance rates and to discourage holidays being taken during term time. Therefore since September 2013 it has been decided that all absences due to holidays should not be authorised by any Headteachers within the six Local Authorities in the South West and Mid Wales Consortium.

Taking a holiday during term time means that children miss important school time which can impact on their education and other extracurricular activities. It will be difficult for them to catch up on work they have missed. In a busy school day, it

is difficult for schools to find the extra time to help a child catch up. Continued absences can have a detrimental effect on a child's academic work; it can also effect a child's social and emotional wellbeing. There is plenty of educational research which links pupil attainment with attendance. 90% attendance at school equates to $\frac{1}{2}$ day a week missed. This would be 4 whole weeks missed over the school year!

If a child is absent, we ask parents to contact the school between 8.00 - 9.00 a.m. with an explanation. This is important as there have been tragic consequences in other areas because of a lack of communication between parents and school. It is essential therefore that we have the correct telephone numbers so that we can contact you at various times of the day. We endeavour to contact parents if no explanation has been given for an absence and we register pupils in every lesson. But we must emphasise that it is the parents' responsibility to ensure that their child is at school. If a child's attendance is a cause for concern, the Education Welfare Officer, who visits the school weekly, will make investigations and visit the home. From November 2014 Powys Education Authority may issue on the spot fines if a child's attendance falls below 90% or if a child is absent from school without permission for 5 days over a period of 12 weeks.

If a child is absent due to illness (or for any other reason), a letter should be sent explaining the absence on the first day he/she returns; we are required to keep this written explanation in the pupil's file.

We thank all parents who inform us promptly of absence and who send us written explanations on the pupil's return to school.

Iechyd

Teimlo'n sâl yn yr ysgol

Os bydd disgyl yn teimlo'n sâl yn yr ysgol, dylai ddweud wrth athro / athrawes ac fe fydd yn cael ei gymryd i'r Ystafell Feddygol i'w asesu gan y goruchwylwr. Byddwn yn cysylltu â rhiant (neu aelod arall o'r teulu) er mwyn iddynt ddod i nôl y plentyn.

Damweiniau

Rydym yn ffodus fod nifer o aelodau'r staff wedi derbyn hyfforddiant Cymorth Cyntaf llawn. Os bydd plentyn yn cael damwain yn yr ysgol, bydd y Cymhorthyydd Cyntaf agosaf yn ei drin fel bo'n addas neu yn trefnu ei fod yn cael ei gludo (gydag aelod o'r staff yn gwmni) i'r ysbyty neu i'r feddygfa. Rhoddir gwylod i'r rhieni mor fuan â phosib. (Mae'n bwysig bod rhif eich ffôn symudol gennym.) Ni ddylai unrhyw ddisgybl adael tir yr ysgol heb ganiatâd.

Moddion

Os dymunwch i'ch plentyn gymryd moddion yn ystod diwrnod ysgol, anfonwch gyfarwyddiadau mewn llythyr os gwelwch yn dda; bydd y moddion yn cael ei gadw mewn man diogel. Rhowch wybod i ni os oes gan eich plentyn gyflwr meddygol a all effeithio arno yn yr ysgol. Bydd rhieni plant sy'n gor fod cymryd moddion bob dydd yn cydweithio gyda ni i lunio cynllun gofal ysgrifenedig. Dylai plant sy'n dioddef o'r fogfa (asthma) gario anadlydd yn eu meddiant bob amser; mae'n syniad da anfon anadlydd sbâr i'w gadw'n ddiogel yn yr ysgol.

Polisi Iaith

Transport

School buses collect pupils from the district to attend school and the pupils are supervised on arriving and leaving the premises. This service is provided by Powys Education Authority and a good standard of behaviour is expected at all times on the bus to ensure the safety of the passengers and the driver. When transport is required to attend an educational activity, parents/guardians are asked to contribute towards the cost.

Health

Feeling Ill at school

If a pupil feels unwell at school, the teacher should be told and the pupil will be taken to the medical room to be assessed by the supervisor. We will contact parents (or members of the family) so that a child who is unwell can be collected and taken home.

Accidents

We are fortunate that a number of members of our staff are trained first aiders. If a pupil has an accident at school, the nearest first aider will treat him/her as appropriate or arrange for the pupil to be taken (accompanied by a member of staff) to obtain medical attention at the hospital. Parents will be notified as soon as possible. (It is important that parents provide the school with their mobile phone number.) On no account should a pupil leave school without permission.

Medicines

If you wish the school to administer your child's medicine during school hours, please send an explanatory letter to the school; the medicine will be put away for safekeeping. Parents/ carers should inform the school if a child has a medical condition which may affect him/her at school. Parents of pupils who have to take medicine on a regular basis will need to work out a written care plan with the school.

Asthmatic pupils need to keep their inhalers in their possession at all times; it is a good idea to send in a spare inhaler for us to keep in school.

Language Policy

The school has a particularly successful language policy which allows pupils to develop their full potential. Our aim is to help pupils to be as articulate and fully bilingual as possible by the time they leave school. This policy is a progression from the local primary schools' excellent achievements and is a reflection of the Powys Education Authority language strategy for this locality. We are fully aware of the cognitive and educational benefits of bilingualism and we aim to develop the abilities of our pupils in both languages. All departments are aware of their role in developing the linguistic skills of their pupils and teachers are sensitive to the linguistic capabilities of each pupil.

Publicity

From time to time photographs of children taking part in school activities are taken. Some of these photographs may be published in the press or other publicity material. If parents do not wish for their child to be included in publicity photographs then they should indicate so in the school Contact Book.

Who is the course for?

BTEC National Awards are designed to provide specialist work-related qualifications in a range of sectors. They have been designed to provide a preparation for employment and/or to provide career development opportunities. They also provide a recognised pathway to Higher Ed. The National Award is equivalent to 1 A Level.

Previous knowledge required:

You will generally need four relevant GCSEs at grade C or above or an appropriate NVQ Level 2, BTEC First Diploma or Intermediate GNVQ with a satisfactory grade.

What will I study?

The BTEC National Award for Creative Media Production is a six unit qualification.

Students are expected to produce their own short films, either individually or in small groups, which will provide the basis for all the units.

Medical Science is the science of dealing with the maintenance of health and the prevention and treatment of diseases. The Level 3 Diploma in Medical Science is for learners who are interested in careers related to healthcare and medical research. Medical scientists are at the forefront of healthcare services, as they are vital in the diagnosis of disease, determining the effectiveness of treatments and searching for new cures.

In order to achieve the Level 3 Qualification in Medical Science learners are required to complete 3 units:

- Human health and disease
- Physiological measurement techniques
- Medical Science research methods

Unit 1 is an externally assessed exam. Learners will be provided with a pre release article to study before the examination. Unit 1 is worth 50% of the qualification. Units 2 and 3 are assignments which will be marked by the school's teachers. Units 2 and 3 will count towards 50% of the qualification.



Children's Care, Learning and Development

Level 3 Diploma

This course is for all those who wish to work in the children's care, learning and development setting or services in Wales.

It is made up of a mixture of mandatory units, and optional units and covers the age range from birth to

19 years. All units will be a mixture of 'knowledge and understanding' and 'competence and skills'.

You will spend 1 day a week in school for tutorials and 2/3 days a week experience in an early years setting.

Assessment –an assessor will visit you every month to observe and set written tasks.

Units include:

Level 3 Diploma

- Understand the development of children and young people
- Professional practice in early years settings
- Support children's speech, language and communication
- Promote children's experiential learning
- Working with babies and young children to support their development and learning
- Support children's learning in Welsh language development

On completion of the Level 3 Diploma, potential job roles include Cylch Meithrin leader, nursery assistant in a primary school, Foundation Phase assistant in a primary school, nursery nurse or an assistant in a day nursery. You can also progress to the extended part of the Diploma course.

Level 3 Extended Diploma

You will study for a further year and spend 2 days in school for tutorials and 2/3 days experience in an early years setting.

Units include:

- An introduction to leadership and management
- Maintaining the health of children and/or young people

- Support children and/or young people's development of art, drama and music
- Learning styles and their role in learning and achievement
- Supportive approaches to behaviour management
- Supporting numeracy and literacy development in children and/or young people

This extended year gives you a maximum of 168 UCAS points and progression to higher education to study education, nursing or social work.
